

Rome, AD 110 Ignatius, the Bishop of Antioch and defender of the Christian faith, was thrown to the wild beasts today.

Emperor Trajan wanted him torn apart by the animals to discourage people from becoming Christians. But Trajan didn't count on the fiery passion of Ignatius for his Lord. Ignatius was so determined to die for his faith in Jesus that he wrote to the Christians in Rome not to prevent his execution.

He told the Roman Christians,


"I am dying willingly for God's sake, if only you do not prevent it. Allow me to be eaten by the beasts, which are my way of reaching to God. I am God's wheat, and I am to be ground by the teeth of wild beasts, so that I may become the pure bread of Christ." As Ignatius journeyed to his death, many Christians flocked to meet him and he encouraged them. When he arrived at the amphitheatre in Rome, Ignatius was thrown to two fierce lions which immediately devoured him. The death of Bishop Ignatius is a great loss to the church.




