# Epic of the Apostles Acts Volume 1

## Lesson 1: Birth of the New Testament Church in Jerusalem

### Theme:

God gives us His Holy Spirit to live in us and to be His witnesses.

### Lesson Aim:

To trust that the Holy Spirit will give us boldness to share about Jesus with others.

### Bible Passage:

Acts 1:1-11, 26; 2:1-47

### Memory Verse:

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. Acts 1:8



## Learn

### Lesson from the story:

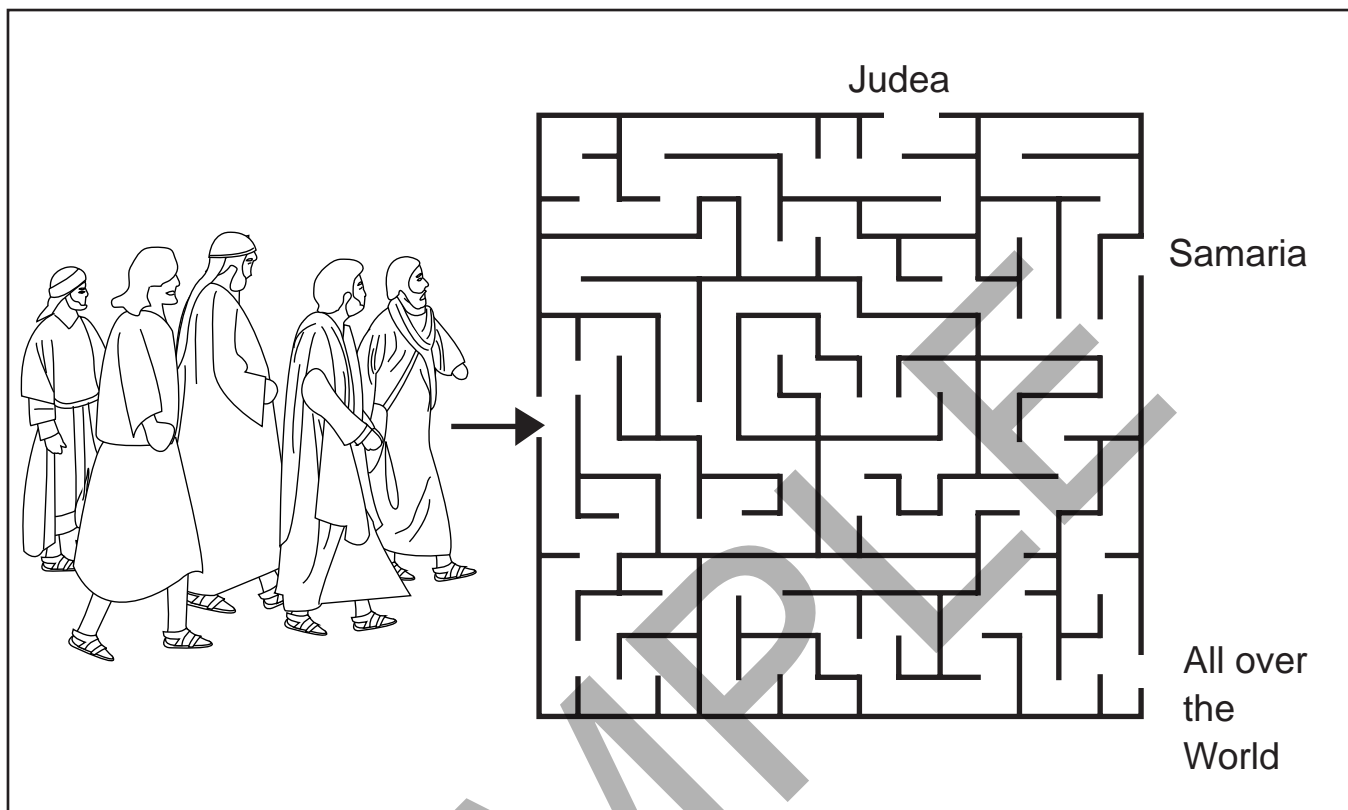
The Holy Spirit came to the apostles in Jerusalem. The church was started that day and many people believed in Jesus.

## Activity 1: Discover - True or False

1. Jesus was taken up into the sky. ( True / False )
2. The angels said Jesus will not come back again. ( True / False )
3. The Holy Spirit gave power to the Christians to tell others about Jesus. ( True / False )
4. When Peter told others about Jesus, they were sorry for their sins and asked Jesus to forgive them. ( True / False )

## Activity 2 - Power to Witness:

Witnessing is telling others about who Jesus is and that he died on the cross to save us. The Holy Spirit gave the believers power to become witnesses for Jesus in Judea, Samaria and all over the world. Colour the believers and help them find the way to their destinations.



### Respond:

#### Object Lesson: Torch and batteries

Bring a torch light and the required number of batteries. Ask the children: "What do we use a torch light for?" Hold up the torch without batteries. Ask: "Can it work without batteries? Why does a torch light need batteries?" Put in the batteries, switch on and shine the torch. We are like the torch light. The Holy Spirit is like the batteries that give us the boldness to tell others about Jesus.

### Lesson Aim:

To talk to our friends about who Jesus is and what He has done for us.

### Bible Passage:

Acts 3:1-25; 4:1-31

### Memory Verse:

Then Peter said, "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk."  
Acts 3:6



## Learn

### Lesson from the story:

Peter and John are not afraid to tell others about Jesus. It is Jesus who heals the lame beggar. It is also Jesus who gives salvation.

## Activity 1: Discover - Circle the correct answer

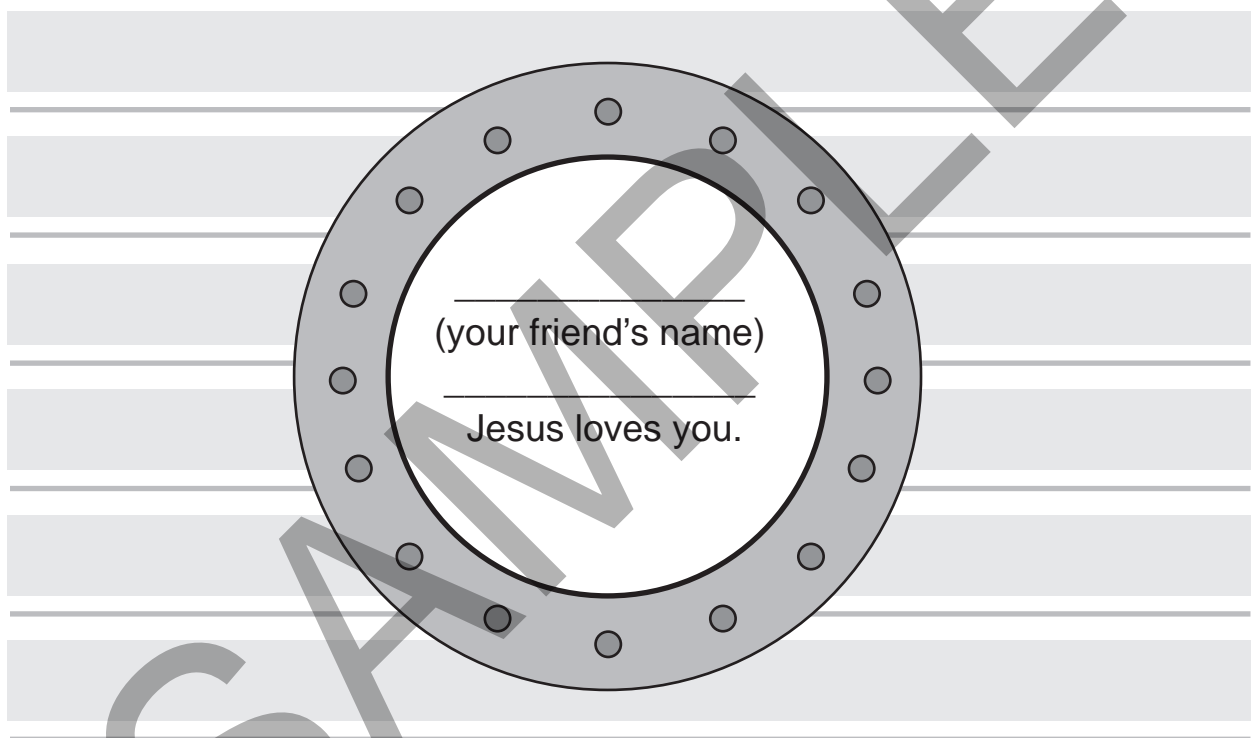

6. Put a small piece of double-sided tape behind the cardboard.
7. Give this to the friend you want to encourage.



### **Respond:**

### Theme:

When we tell lies, we are actually lying to the Holy Spirit and not people.

### Lesson Aim:

To remember that God knows when we tell lies.

### Bible Passage:

Acts 5:1-11

### Memory Verse:

Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices. Colossians 3:9.



## Learn

### Lesson from the story:

What happened to Ananias and his wife was a warning that we cannot lie to God.

## **Activity 2: Happy or Sad?**

Note to teachers: Prepare square sheets of coloured card measuring 12cm x 12cm, one for each child. Get crayons for the class. Get each child to draw a smiley face on one side of the card, and a sad face on the other side. Then, tell 3 examples of telling the truth or telling a lie, and ask the children to show how they would feel if they are the person in the story by holding up the happy or sad face. If you have a volunteer or assistant teacher, both of you may act out the scene.

Eg: Billy found a shiny robot on the floor and kept it in his bag. When Joe asked Billy if Billy saw his missing toy robot, Billy said no. If you are Joe, how would you feel?



Eg: Suzie broke a vase while playing in the house. She told her mother and said sorry. If you were Suzie's mother, how would you feel?



### **Respond:**

God is happy when we tell the truth. If we are honest, other people will be happy, too. God is sad and angry when we tell a lie. Even when nobody knows we are lying, God knows. Can you remember when you told a lie? Ask Jesus to forgive you. Then say sorry to the person you lied to.

### **Application:**

Sometimes, we are afraid to tell the truth. But remember that God wants us to be honest. The next time you feel like telling a lie, remember to tell the truth.

### **Prayer:**

Lord Jesus, forgive me because I have lied before. From now on, help me to always be honest. Amen.

## Lesson 4: Life in the Early Jerusalem Church - A Miraculous Prison Break

### Theme:

It is better to fear God and obey Him than to fear man.

### Lesson Aim:

To obey God even when we are afraid of the people around us.

### Bible Passage:

Acts 5:17-42

### Memory Verse:

Peter and the other apostles replied, "We must obey God rather than men!" Acts 5:29



## Learn

### Lesson from the story:

Even when the Christians were put in prison and threatened, they would not stop speaking about Jesus. They were convinced that they must obey God rather than men.

## Lesson 5: Stephen – Persecution and Scattering of the Jerusalem Church

### **Theme:**

We must forgive those who do evil to us.

### **Lesson Aim:**

To learn about Stephen's example and forgive those who treat us badly.

### **Bible Passage:**

Acts 6:1–8:3

### **Memory Verse:**

For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. Matthew 6:14.



## Learn

### **Lesson from the story:**

Stephen, the first believer to die for his faith, follows the example of the Lord Jesus by asking God to forgive those who stoned him to death.

## **Object Lesson: Forgiving Others**

You will need: 3 baskets with heavy items inside such as rocks or bricks (distribute the rocks unevenly so that there are heavy, medium and light baskets), raffia string as finishing line, a big box labeled "Jesus".

Instructions: Put children into three groups. Each group is given a basket with rocks. Each member of the group takes turn to carry the basket and walk towards the raffia string and back, then passes it to the next member until everyone has finished.

Ask: Which basket was the easiest to carry?

Tell the children: Imagine that the basket is our life, and the rocks are the bad feelings and thoughts we keep because we don't forgive others who have hurt us. The more unforgiveness we have, the heavier our basket is. When we forgive others, we will not be angry at the person anymore. Jesus asks us to forgive others and he will forgive us. (Get the children to pour the rocks into the box labeled "Jesus" as a sign of forgiving others.)

### **Respond:**

Jesus forgives us if we confess our sin. Jesus also wants us to forgive the people who treat us badly.

### Lesson Aim:

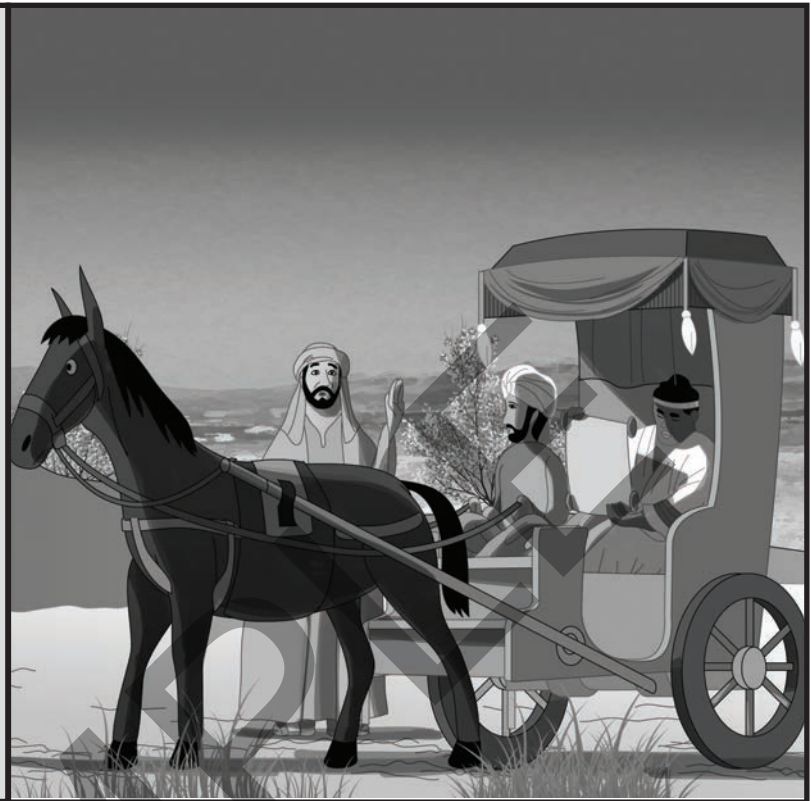
To check our lives to see if we are following what God wants us to do.

## Learn

### Lessons from the story:

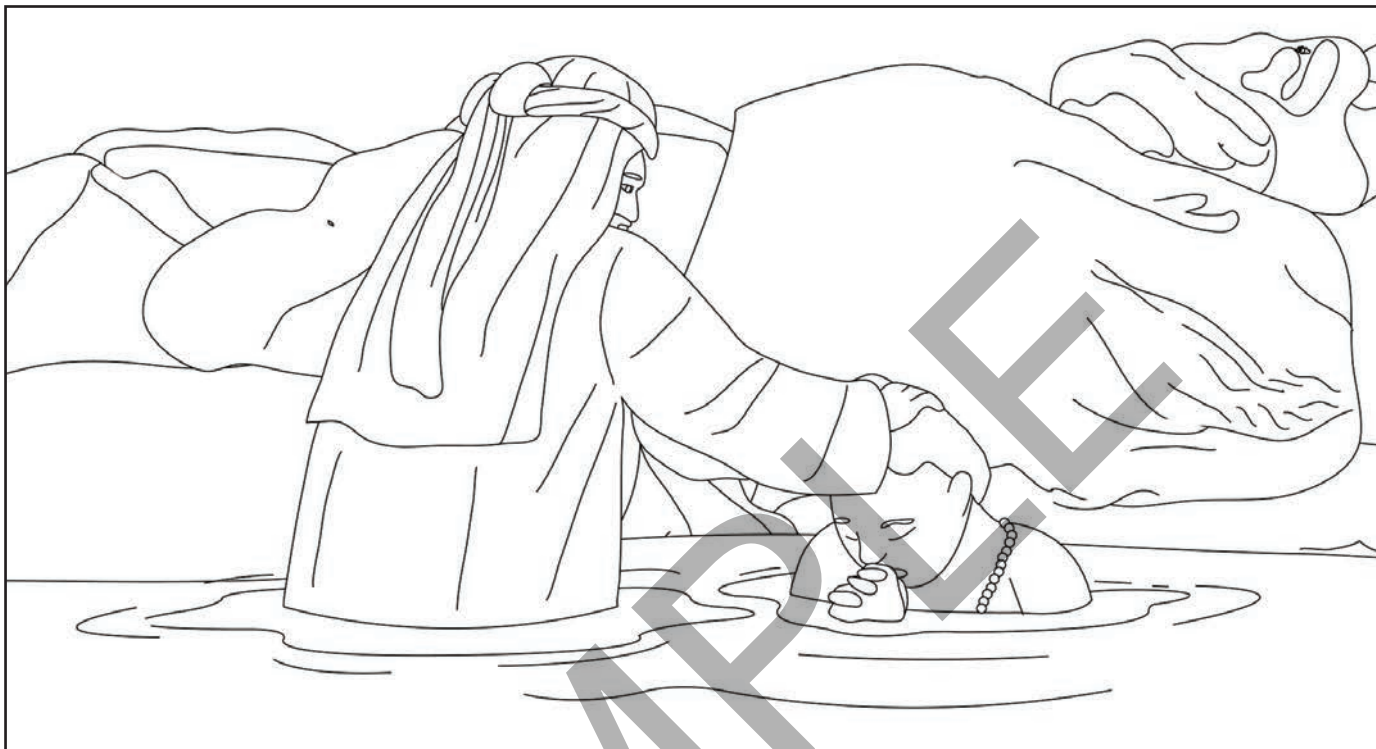
The persecution of the church causes Christians to run away from Jerusalem to Judea and Samaria. There, they continue preaching about Jesus.

### Lessons from the story:

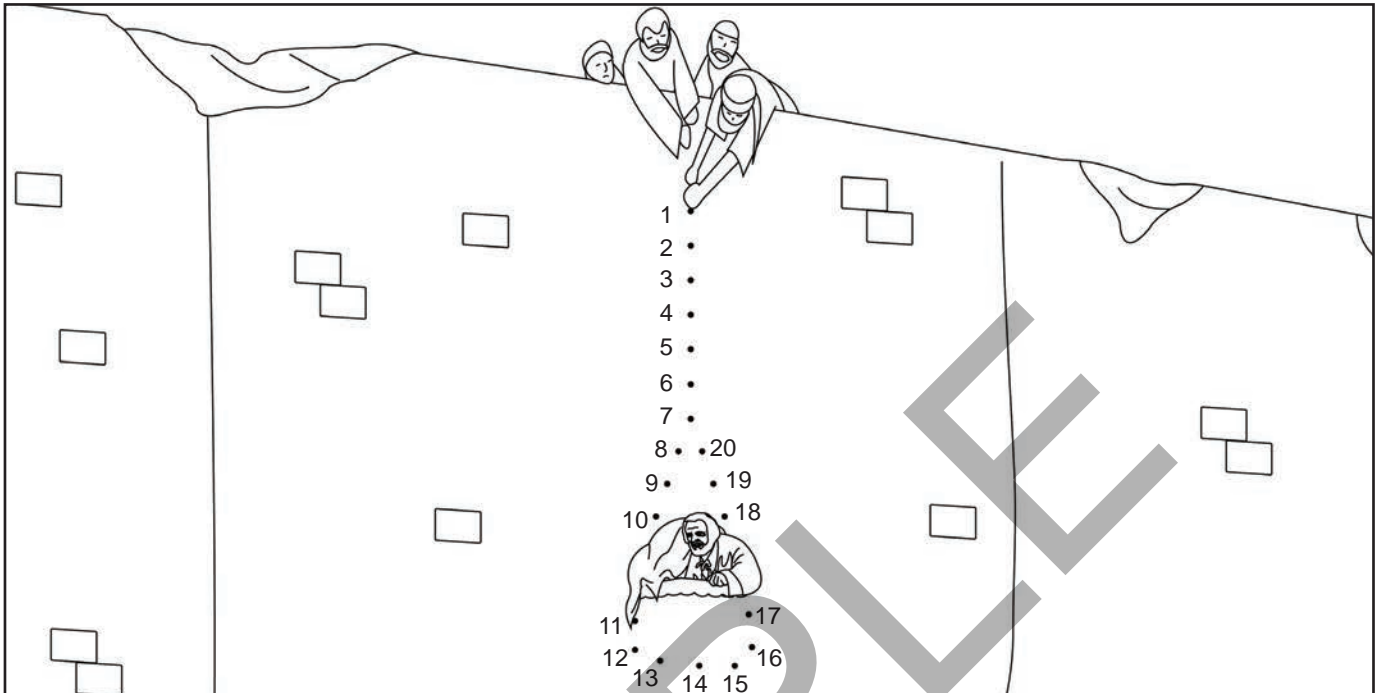
Barnabas was an encourager. Others were afraid of Saul, but Barnabas saw that Saul had truly changed and told the other Christians to accept him.

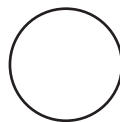
### Lessons from the story:

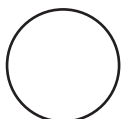

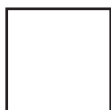

### Lessons from the story:

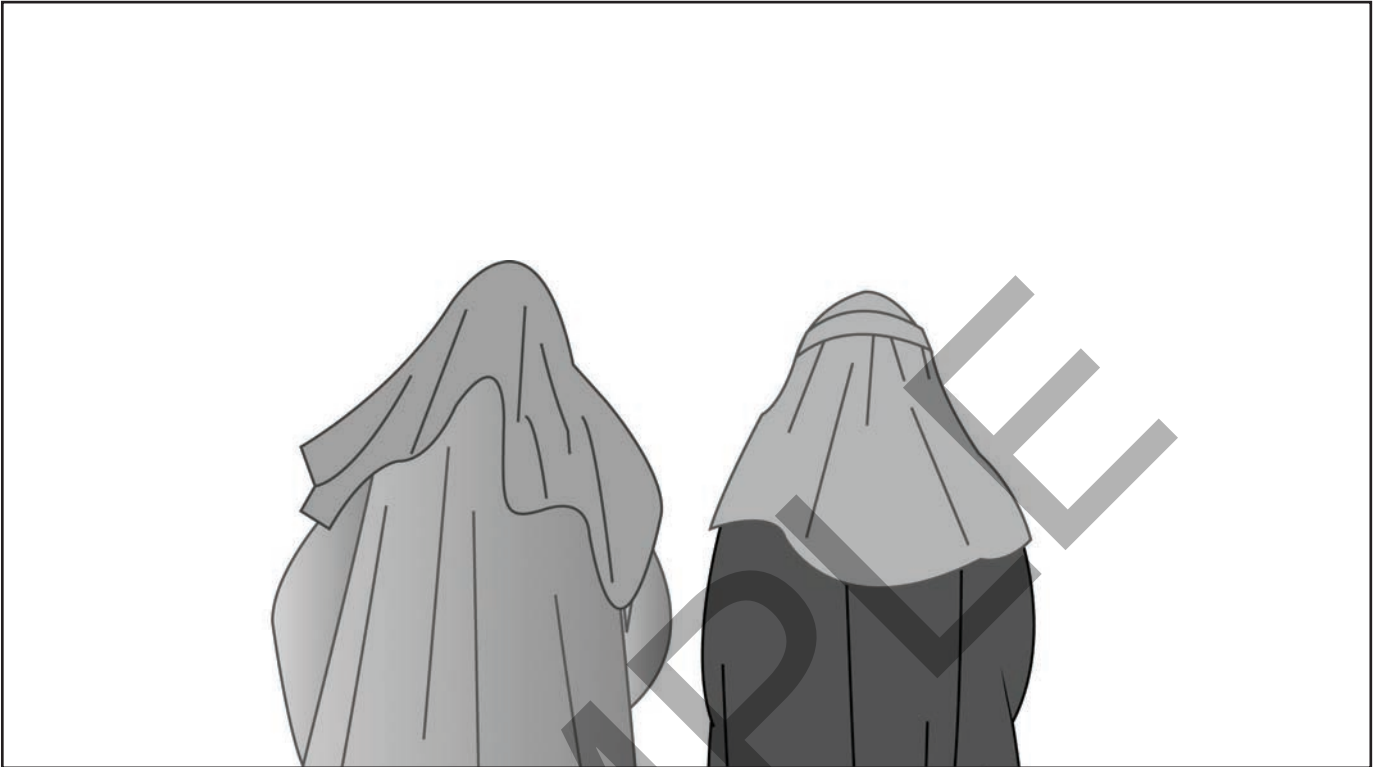

## **Activity 2: Game - Jesus, Please Help Us**

Note for teacher: Break the class into two groups. Group 1 has to carry their Bibles from one end of the class to the other. Group 2 has to scrunch newspaper into small balls and throw at the group travelling with their Bibles. When the newspaper balls hit them, Group 1 shouts "Jesus, Please Help Us" and Group 2 has to freeze in action for 3 seconds. Once Group 1 reaches the finishing line, swap roles.

Debrief: Discuss with the children:

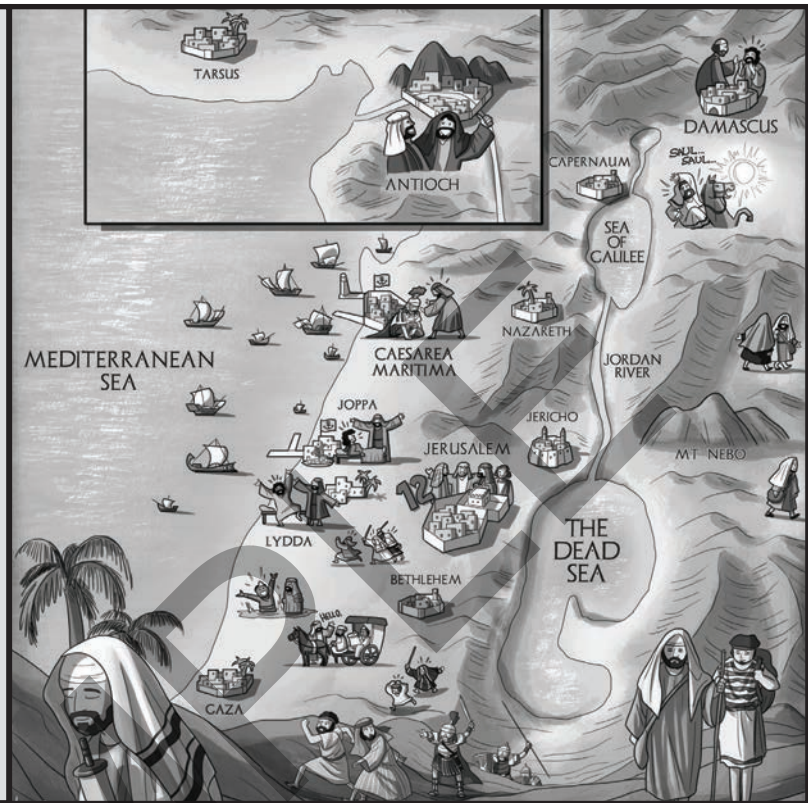
