What Did We See?

Adam and Eve Disobeyed God

- God gave one rule
- Adam and Eve broke the rule
- This is called sin

Discussion: Sin means disobeying God's rules



Sin Breaks Things

Sin Brings Sadness

- Sin brought sadness
- Sin brought pain
- Sin brought separation from God

Discussion: God was sad, but He did not stop loving them



Watch and Learn

God Showed Love

- God looked for Adam and Eve
- God talked to them and made clothes for them

God Had a Plan

- God promised a Rescuer
- One day, Jesus would come
- God's love is bigger than sin



Discussion: God planned for people even after they disobeyed and planned to fix what was broken

What Does This Mean For Me?

God Still Loves Me

- I make mistakes
- God still loves me
- God wants us to tell him we are sorry
- God helps me choose the right things to do

Discussion: God forgives us when we turn to Him. He still loves us and wants us to choose right
