God's Faithful Heroes: Noah and the Ark

God loves those who trust in Him, even when they are not perfect. He takes care of those who trust Him.

Old Testament

- Today we are starting a new part of the Bible called the Old Testament.
- These stories happened before Jesus was born
- They tell us about Bible heroes – real people who loved God, made mistakes, and learned to trust Him



Thought: God was working even before Jesus came.

Why Learn About Bible Heroes

Why these stories matter

- God shows His love to people
- God helps and protects those who trust Him
- Those who continually refuse to obey God face God's punishment
- These stories point to God's character and the coming of Jesus

Thought: These stories help us understand why we need Jesus
