## Moses and the Passover

### God sends Moses to help save His people

- The children of Israel slaves in Egypt for 430 years
- God sent Moses to deliver Israel
- Egypt had received 9 plagues
- Each time when Pharaoh agreed to let God's people go, the plague was removed.
- When the plague was removed, Pharaoh said "No" again.
- Now there was going to be a 10<sup>th</sup> plague that would be terrible but God had a special plan to protect His people.

- They put its blood on the doorposts
- When the angel saw the blood, he passed over that house
