Jesus Died For Our Sins

- Jesus was crucified on the cross
- He died to take away our sins
- He did this because He loves us

- Jesus did not stay in the grave
- God raised Him back to life

Jesus Appeared To His Friends

Jesus Comforted His Friends

- Jesus appeared to His friends
- He encouraged them by staying with them for a while
- They knew it was really Him

Thomas Learns to Believe

- Thomas wanted to see before he would believe that Jesus was really alive
- Jesus showed Himself to Thomas
- Thomas believed.

Jesus said, "Blessed are those who have not seen, yet believe!"



What We Can Learn

Jesus Is Alive Today

- He died for our sins
- He did this because He loved us
- He rose from the dead and comforted His friends
- He is alive today and we can talk with Him

Jesus said to Thomas, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." (John 20:29 NIVUK)
